Ninety-Ninth Annual Dinner

Please join us on Saturday, April 28, 2018 for the Ninety-Ninth Annual Dinner of the Officers of the First Division at the Hilton Alexandria Mark Center, Alexandria, VA. The Dinner commemorates the 100th Anniversary of the end of World War I. Dr. Paul Herbert, Executive Director of the First Division Museum at Cantigny, will be the Guest Speaker.

The dinner is an annual event for Commissioned and Warrant Officers assigned or attached to the First Infantry Division during combat operations, including KFOR and SFOR, and those officers currently serving with the Big Red One. Founded in 1919 after World War I, the Dinner is held on the last Saturday in April every year with a program that remains largely unchanged – cocktails at 1800; mess call at 1900; regimental colors on display; former commanders on the dais; the band playing regimental marches; an update from the current CG; and a toast to our fallen comrades followed by taps and Auld Lang Syne. Why attend? One previous participant remarked, “The dinner was an amazing event, just being in the room with all of these professionals was awesome and humbling.”

As we approach the dinner’s 100th anniversary in 2019, the Committee is working to increase attendance. The Chairman has set a goal of 350 guests for the 100th dinner in 2019, and we can achieve that goal with your continued participation and support, especially your outreach to other veteran officers of the Division.

ATTENDANCE AND GUEST POLICY

Each member attending the annual Dinner can bring one guest: a spouse, child, or someone with a close relationship to the Division, such as former Division commanders or the First Division museum curator. Surviving spouses of members are also invited. All attendees to the Dinner are welcome to attend the chili luncheon on Saturday and the cocktail reception prior to the dinner and to join the veteran officers in the unit CPs throughout the weekend.
